Let us know what you'd like to teach in the form of a short proposal. The work of ITV course developer would begin in July, 2006 with training and financial assistance provided by SVETN. Depending on preparation needed, classes could begin as early as Fall 2006.

Recently, SVETN high schools have sought to pool their increasingly scarce resources to engage a teacher who no longer wants to work full time but would derive professional satisfaction from teaching just one class of highly motivated students.

In preparing your proposal, please focus on content not typically offered in the regions' smaller high schools, including especially foreign languages, AP or advanced level classes in any subject, or dual credit offerings. Course developers will be offered the opportunity (but not required) to use a web-based computer application called ANGEL to receive homework submissions, facilitate grade records, and encourage small group interactions.
